

Bryan High School PTSO Minutes
October 19, 2009

- I. Call to Order – Janice Clark called meeting to order at 12:10 p.m.
- II. Introduction of Members
- III. Approval of Minutes – Jenni Micheletti made a motion to approve September 21, 2009 minutes and Michele Pharr seconded. Board approved.
- IV. Treasurer’s Report – Lori Eike presented the report showing deposits of \$21,236.73 and disbursements of \$3,539.65 for an ending balance of \$17,697.08.
- V. Principals Report – Maria Fields presented the report. The College Career night was very successful. Report cards were distributed and are also on-line. The mock lock down went well and the practice will help alleviate problem situations if a real lock down is required. 10/23-A Pep Rally is scheduled and the ROTC will host a dinner at Silver Campus cafeteria before the game. The football team is tied 4 ways for district at this date. The Student Council is selling pink t-shirts 10/19-30 for “Tackle For the Cure” Pink Out the Stadium on 10/30 at football game to benefit breast cancer research. 10/30-Spanish club will host a chili dinner at Silver campus before the game. 10/19-23-exit level tests scheduled. Results on PSAT have not been received as of this date. Pink wristbands are currently being sold by school to purchase items to encourage faculty, staff and students battling cancer. Teachers will be wearing college t-shirts every Thursday. The school purchased the “water hog” rugs and the banners are being ordered. The Viking Club donated a \$1000 toward the Sound System needed. Students have organized “Terrific Tuesday” where the students dress up in business or church attire each Tuesday of the week beginning 10/20.
- VI. Teacher Report – Colleen Holmes presented a fund raiser the Junior class is sponsoring to finance the Senior Prom. She stated sales were down and that Prom tickets were being increased to \$30 each for early sales and \$35 for late sales. She stated the Science department need an ice machine to facilitate lab experiments and requested \$840 to purchase it. Julie Porter made a motion to approve request, seconded by Marion Stoessel. Board approved.

- VIII. Committee Reports:

She displayed a purse made from Go Big Blue YS size t-shirt, also. Plans to sell long sleeve t-shirts and hoodies by 10/30 are being finalized. The “Spirit” towel sales were very successful. The next meeting is scheduled 10/20 at 6 p.m. in Silver Campus cafeteria. Donations from solicitation letters are being received.
- e. Honors Lunch – A committee was formed to decide how to proceed with the honors recognition. Some suggestions were: The “non-traditional food day” date of 12/11 was selected to honor students from the 1st and 2nd six weeks so we could offer a cookie and soft drink along with pizza rolls. A coupon for each student is being pursued instead of a drawing at this time. Julie Porter suggested an invitation be given to each qualifying student to come by and get dessert. The next “non-traditional day” date of 4/23 was discussed to honor the 3rd, 4th and 5th six weeks students. The committee will present the plans at next meeting.
