

## **Bryan High PTSO Minutes November 19, 2007**

- I. Call to Order – Darla Easterling called the meeting to order at noon.
- II. Introduction of Members
- III. Approval of Minutes – the minutes of the October 15, 2007 meeting were presented for approval as recorded by Julie Clark for Marcy Ullmann. Motion was made to accept by Julie Porter, seconded by Janice Clark and passed unanimously.
- IV. Treasurer’s Report – Marcy Ullmann presented the report. For Bryan High, current balance as of November 17, 2007 is \$23,243.68. Activity included deposits of \$6,216.15 and disbursements of \$3,522.20. For Rudder High the current balance is \$6,618.10 with deposits of \$212.00 and disbursements of \$1,717.85.

- VI. Special Report – Janice Greeno, Technology Specialist reported on the Net Day Speak-up Survey. She provided a hand-out to members. This was a survey given to 500 BHS students on use of technology, on-line learning and using technology effectively. Because of the school’s participation BHS was honored with a ranking of #5 out of 100 in the nation. Internet Safety will be discussed in all Advocacy classes.
- VII. Principal’s Report – Carol Cune thanked everyone who participated in the Teacher Appreciation Luncheon. Tuesday, Nov. 20 all English Classes will be practicing bus evacuation. This is a State Law and must be done twice a year. Report Card Mail-out is scheduled for Monday, Nov. 26. Maria passed around a sign-up sheet. Meet at 8:45 a.m. in the Blue Faculty Lounge. KBTX Food for Families Food Drive is scheduled for Dec. 6. Concentration this year will be on paper goods, rice and beans. Mrs. Cune asked the PTSO for \$250 to help with this effort. The money will be used to purchase these items from Sam’s. Motion was made to approve this donation by Julie Porter, seconded by Janice Clark, passed unanimously. Basketball Season is underway. Please support both the boy’s and girl’s teams. Tennis is over until January, Gymnastics Team won their last tournament. BHS now has a Bowling Club. Try-outs will be held Tuesday after Thanksgiving. Cost is \$90 and this will cover shoes, lane expenses, etc. Mrs. Cune also discussed the standardized dress proposal. Pants will be solid khaki, navy or black. Shorts must be knee length and shirts must have a collar and be a solid color. Logos on the shirt cannot be larger than 1 ½ inches. Reasoning behind the dress code is it will help students focus on the business of school, enhances the learning environment, improve school safety, lessen socioeconomic differences and encourages modesty. Further discussion will be held at the December 3 BISD Trustee meeting.

  - A. Candy Sales – Janice Clark reported that sales are continuing. She had a suggestion to hang a flag near their location on days they are selling candy to alert the students. Mrs. Cune will check on this for her.
