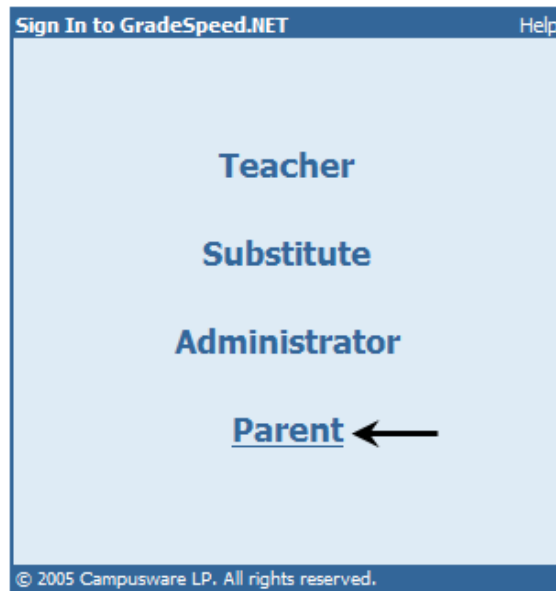


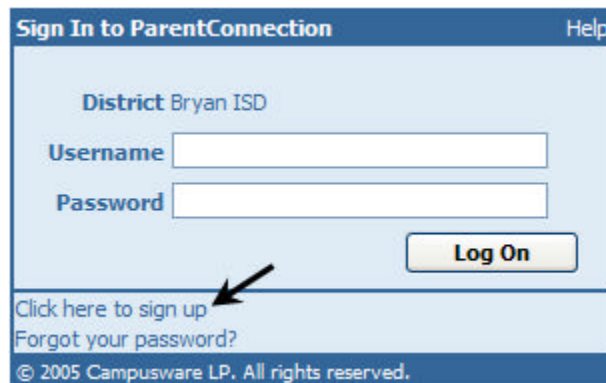
Parent Connection

Step 1: Create Your Account.

1. Open an Internet Browser (Example: Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari)
2. In the address bar type in the following url: <http://grades.bryanisd.org>
3. You should now see the screen shown below. Click on the **Parent** link.



4. You should now see the Parent Sign In page. Click on the "Click here to sign up" link.



5. Enter your information into the fields provided. Fields with a red asterics (*) are required and can not be left blank. Also keep in mind that your password must contain 6 characters and have both letters and numbers in it. For example, password1 or johndoe3 etc.
6. Once you have filled in all of the required fields you may read over the User Agreement, then check the agreement box and click **Sign Up**.

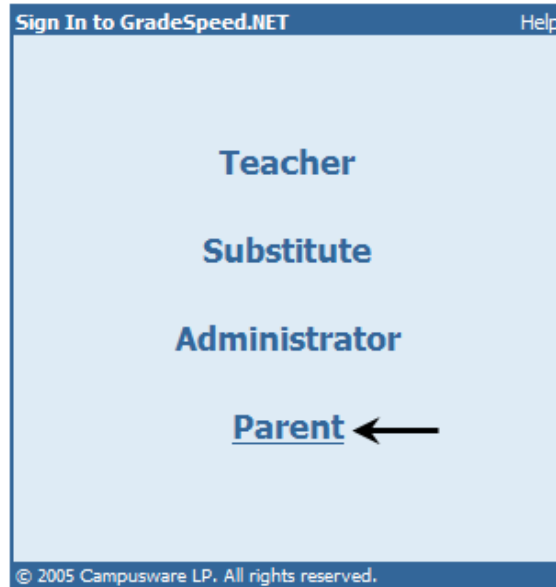

Step 2: Log into ParentConnection and add Students

1. Open an Internet Browser (Example: Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari)
2. In the address bar type in the following url: <http://grades.bryanisd.org>
3. You should now see the screen shown below. Click on the **Parent** link



4. You should now see the Parent Sign In page. Enter your user name and password and click **Log On**.



5. You will now see the ParentConnection home screen. If this is your first time to login to ParentConnection you will need to add you student(s) to your account. Click on the **Add a student to my account** link

6. Fill in **all** fields on the **Application for Access to New Students** page. Make sure to read the guidelines listed above the forum to prevent possible delays in gaining access to your student.
7. Click **Submit**.

Application for Access to New Students

Please add the information below for each new student you wish to apply for. All fields are required, and please enter the information accurately. This information will be compared against student records as a qualification for approval.

Please do not use nicknames, but rather the student's full legal name.

The student's **First** and **Last** name must match the name on the student's birth certificate. *(Do not include generation indicators such as Jr., Sr, III or the application will be Denied)*

StudentID's are **NOT** the same as their Social Security numbers.

The last 4 digits of the student's Social Security number is now **required** to gain access to student's grades and attendance information.

8. If all of the information entered on the forum matched BISDs records you should receive the following message as well as an email letting you know you've been approved.



(If your application was denied, you may either delete the application from the “Manage Students” link and re-apply or contact you student’s campus staff for assistance.)

New Features

** - **Assignment Detail** – There is now an “Assignments” link under the *Select a section:* menu on the Welcome screen. This allows the parent to see more detail on an assignment and download any documentation that may be attached to it.

** - **Notes** – On the “Student Grades” page there is not a coloum called *Notes* By click on the Note link you can directly communicate with the teacher.

** - **Multiple Account Email Addresses** - Under the “My Settings” option you may now add multiple email accounts to your ParentConnection account. Click the *Add Email* button and insert a secondary email or change your primary email.

FAQ:

Can I see my student's assignments? Yes you can! Navigate to the Student Grades page. Click on an average in one of the Cycle average columns. At the bottom of the page you will now see details on student's assignments and test.

What does an Inc, Exc or Msg mean? The abbreviations stand for Incomplete (Inc), Excused (Exc) and Missing (Msg). Incomplete and Excused assignments are not counted against a student's average. A Missing assignment however counts as a 0.

Why are some of the Assignments missing grades? If an assignment has a blank grade this means the teacher hasn't entered a grade yet. Blank grades are not counted against a student's average.

Is there a way to contact a teacher through ParentConnection? There is no direct communication between ParentConnection and teachers such as chatting however most teachers have entered their email address into the gradebook. To retrieve the teacher's email address, navigate to the Student Grades page and click on the teacher's name. This will open your default mail client with the teacher's email address in the "To" field.

Is there a way I can have an email sent to me when my student's grade goes below a certain point? This can be done from the Triggers page. On the left hand side of the browser, click on the Triggers link. Once you're on the Triggers page, click the check box next to "Watch Grades". You can be notified of whether your student's grades go above or below a certain point by toggling the buttons "Bellow" & "Above" and filling in the grade in the "an average of" field. Make sure you click the "Send E-mail" box!!

Is there a way I can be notified if my student is absent? This can be done from the Triggers page. On the left hand side of the browser, click on the Triggers link. Once you're on the Triggers page, click the check box next to "Watch Attendance". By setting this option, any time your student is absent or tardy you will be notified. Make sure you click the "Send E-mail" box!!

Can I change my address after I've created an account? Yes. Click on "My Settings" link on the left hand side of the browser. Here you can edit and update your information. The only information that you can not update is your name and username. Once you're finished, click the "Save" button.
